



The story began way back in 1893, and the Buchegger family has devoted itself diligently to winegrowing ever since then. Vines have a much longer tradition in Gedersdorf – first mentioned in an official document in 1190 – where most of the vineyards of the Buchegger estate are growing. At that time, the local monasteries owned vineyards and harvested the best grapes from parcels in the Holzgasse or Moosburgerin, which 800 years ago bore the same names as they do today.

In 2006, Weingut Buchegger moved its cellar to Dross, and the first harvest was vinified here that year, while the eleven hectares of vine-yards naturally remained rooted in Gedersdorf. Primarily, Grüner Veltliner and Riesling grow in these vineyards, but one also finds the varieties Roter Veltliner, Chardonnay and Zweigelt.
