Native Yeast
100% destemmed 2t stainless steel
20 days on skins
6 months natural MLF in Barrels
100% French oak, 30% new
14 months in wood with 1 racking

TASTING NOTES

Dark in color and fruit expression, with exotic spice perfume and wonderful structure, complexity and length, with velvety firm tannins and bright acidity that balance the depth of fruit.

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
