

# Weingut Familie Pitnauer "BIENENFRESSER" ZWEIGELT DAC Carnuntum

Wine has been made under the name Pitnauer for generations. The Pitnauer family was first mentioned as a family in Göttlesbrunn in the 18th century. The most significant development occurred in the 1980s, when Hans and Edith Pitnauer began to concentrate entirely on viticulture. During this time, they revolutionized red winemaking in Carnuntum and took it to a new level.

In 1986, the pressence of the exotic bird Bienenfresser (Bee-eater Merops Apiaster) in the vineyeards of Göttlesbrunn inspired the naming of our house and the dedication to find the best Zweigelt. This is how this colorful bird became the Emblem of our red wine commitment. Over the years the Bienenfresser has won many awards at home and abroad awarded and achieved cult status. A confirmation of our quality work and at the same time an incentive to continue to produce an exceptional Zweigelt.

Dark ruby red color, intense cherry on the nose, underlined with chocolate and nut nougat; creamy texture, juicy and smooth, yet well-structured tannins. Ripe and juicy with a long, mild finish.
