



## Château Macquin

### AOC Saint Georges - Saint Emilion

Less than 200 ha, the appellation Saint Georges-Saint Emilion is the smallest appellation close to the Saint Emilion appellation. Château Macquin was created by Albert Macquin, first agronomic engineer to plant again after the phylloxera of the late 19th century. It is a 31 ha vineyard, mainly merlot planted, giving strong wines, generous, almost as famous as Saint Emilion wines.



#### COUNTRY

France

#### VARIETAL

80% Merlot  
10% Cabernet Sauvignon  
10% Cabernet Franc

#### SOIL TYPE

Clay and calcareous soils

#### VINEYARD

31 hectares of vineyards,  
predominantly planted with Merlot

#### HARVEST

Grapes harvested by machine &  
sorted on a sorting table before put  
in the tank for a long maceration.

#### VINIFICATION

Fermented in stainless steel and  
thermo-regulated vats, and aged in  
1/3 in oak barrels over 12 months,  
using 25% new oak

#### TASTING NOTES

Garnet-red color. Intense nose with  
ripe red fruits lightly woody. In the  
mouth, fresh and rich, mellowed  
tannins with great intensity.
