

# Domaine Philippe Bouzereau Fils PULIGNY-MONTRACHET IER CRU LES CHAMPS GAINS AOC Puligny-Montrachet

It is at the foot of the vineyards of the old Chateau Clos de Citeaux that takes place this Domaine, in the heart of the village of Meursault. The work of the vine is a family tradition since 9 generations. In 2006, Philippe Bouzereau Jr. took over the Domaine to perpetuate the savoir-faire in the development of Grand Vins de Bourgogne. From Aloxe-Corton in the north, to Santenay in the south, through Beaune, Auxey-Duresses, Meursault and Puligny-Montrachet, a multitude of small parcelles make up the mosaic of these wines. This allows to offer to the tasting a great diversity of soils.

Chardonnay

# **SOIL TYPE**

Chalky and limestone with lots of stones and rocks in the topsoil.

# **VINEYARD**

Upper side of Montrachet facing southeast with higher elevation which gives the vines more cooling influences.

#### **HARVEST**

Manual harvested & sorted

# VINIFICATION

Pneumatic pressing, fermentation on fine lees, in oak barrels, with regular stirring. Bottling after 18 months of aging including 12 months in barrels (30% new oak) then 6 months in a stainless still vats.

## **TASTING NOTES**

This 2022 has a refined bouquet offering subtle and seductive notes of citrus, peach and exotic fruits combined with delicate toasty notes. The palate is rich and well-balanced with a smooth mouthfeel and taut, mineral structure. A very harmonious wine with exceptional aromatic persistency.
