

# Domaine Lamy-Pillot IER CRU LES VERGERS AOC Chassagne-Montrachet

This winery is located in the heart of the village of Chassagne-Montrachet and his family have been winegrowers here since the middle of the 17th Century. They own 15 hectares of vineyards, mostly in the appellations of Saint Aubin & Chassagne Montrachet, producing both white and red wines. They are also part of the 15 only privileged proprietors of the most prestigious Cotes de Beaune Grand Cru: Le Montrachet, with 0.0542 hectare making around 300 bottles each year.



# COUNTRY

France

## VARIETAL

Chardonnay

## **SOIL TYPE**

Mix of stony limestone and shallow clay rich in iron with 28% sand, 53% silt and 19% clay.

#### **VINEYARD**

Located north of the village at 787 feet above sea level and facing east.

## **HARVEST**

Hand harvested in small crates to avoid premature squeeze during transportation to the winery and then hand sorted in a dark atmosphere with neon light on the table to distinguish the maturation color of each grapes and eliminate the unripe or rotten ones.

# **VINIFICATION**

12 to 18 months (varies each vintages) in barrels with only 25% new oak, from different areas of France and Eastern Europe.

## **TASTING NOTES**

Gourmet aromas of citrus and exotic fruits, vanilla, hazelnuts and white flowers. Round and aromatic mouthfeel with a finish that never seems to end. Pure, clean, focused, intense, and polished.
