

# Domaine René Lamy

AOC Chassagne-Montrachet

René Lamy's winery is located in the heart of the village of Chassagne-Montrachet and his family have been winegrowers here since the middle of the 17th Century. They own 15 hectares of vineyards, mostly in the appellations of Saint Aubin & Chassagne Montrachet, producing both white and red wines. They are also part of the 15 only privileged proprietors of the most prestigious Côtes de Beaune Grand Cru: Le Montrachet, with 0.0542 hectare making around 300 bottles each year.

#### **VINEYARD**

Les Morichots; Les Essarts; Les Fontaine Sot; Les Lombardes 2.8 hectares Exposition South-east 40-50 year old vines

#### **HARVEST**

Hand harvested in small crates to avoid premature squeeze during transportation to the winery and then hand sorted in a dark atmosphere with neon light on the table to distinguish the maturation color of each grapes and eliminate the unripe or rotten ones.

#### **VINIFICATION**

Aged 12-18 Months in Barrels 25% New Oak

## **TASTING NOTES**

Generous and seductive wine with amazing complexity showing off at its early age but we still recommend carafing it. Intense notes of white flowers, candied lemon skin, minerals and hazelnut involving to brioche, gingerbread and spices with aeration. Powerful wine with great texture and finesse.

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
