



**Domaine René Lamy**  
**CHASSAGNE-MONTRACHET 1ER CRU "MORGEOT"**  
AOC Chassagne-Montrachet 1er Cru

René Lamy's winery is located in the heart of the village of Chassagne-Montrachet and his family have been winegrowers here since the middle of the 17th Century. They own 15 hectares of vineyards, mostly in the appellations of Saint Aubin & Chassagne Montrachet, producing both white and red wines. They are also part of the 15 only privileged proprietors of the most prestigious Côtes de Beaune Grand Cru: Le Montrachet, with 0.0542 hectare making around 300 bottles each year.

**COUNTRY**

France

**VARIETAL**

Chardonnay

**SOIL TYPE**

The red soil on the top is porous, shallow with small stones overlying bedrock but gets deeper lower down the slope where the soil is white, heavy, compacted and clayey.

**VINEYARD**

The total appellation is 5.65 acres on a gradual slope.

**HARVEST**

Hand harvested, sorted in dark room with neon light on table to distinguish maturation and quality.

**VINIFICATION**

12 to 18 months (varies each vintages) in barrels with only 25% new oak, from different areas of France and Eastern Europe.

**TASTING NOTES**

Intense but elegant aromas of hawthorn flower, apricot, Mirabelle evolving towards almond and rare spices. Opulent, rich and unctuous with less minerals than its neighbors. Very round palate, beautiful structure with relatively high acidity lending great character to the wine.

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
