



Domaine Lamy-Pillot

AOC Chassagne-Montrachet Pot Bois

This winery is located in the heart of the village of Chassagne-Montrachet and his family have been winegrowers here since the middle of the 17th Century. They own 15 hectares of vineyards, mostly in the appellations of Saint Aubin & Chassagne Montrachet, producing both white and red wines. They are also part of the 15 only privileged proprietors of the most prestigious Cotes de Beaune Grand Cru: Le Montrachet, with 0.0542 hectare making around 300 bottles each year.



COUNTRY

France

VARIETAL

Chardonnay

SOIL TYPE

Thin and on a pebbly limestone with marls and sand on a Jurassic basis.

VINEYARD

Located on a slope uphill from 1er Cru Les Cailleret, facing southeast and planted in 2001.

HARVEST

Hand harvested in small crates to avoid premature squeeze during transportation to the winery and then hand sorted in a dark atmosphere with neon light on the table to distinguish the maturation color of each grapes and eliminate the unripe or rotten ones.

VINIFICATION

12 to 18 months (varies each vintages) in barrels with only 25% new oak, from different areas of France and Eastern Europe.

TASTING NOTES

Great complexity and length. This Single Vineyard Pot Bois is very elegant with subdued notes of white flowers, yellow fruit, acacia and vanilla. These aromas are also reflected in the taste and the fine acids give a nice tension.

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
