

# Domaine Comte Senard CORTON GRAND CRU BLANC AOC Corton

Domaine Comte Senard had an auspicious start in 1857 when Jules Senard, the great grandfather of current owner Philippe Senard, created the Corton- Clos des Meix monopole. Since that time, the Domaine has continued its acquisition of property in prestigious appellations, with current holdings of 22 acres of land. Passed down for 5 generations, since 2005 it has been under the management of Lorraine Senard. The Domaine produces wines that are seductive representations of the power of Corton, built to age with finesse and grace.



# COUNTRY

France

## VARIETAL

Chardonnay 15 years old vines

## **SOIL TYPE**

Almost no clay in the topsoil which is made of silt and sand over white marl. Up to 30% slope.

# **VINEYARD**

1.13 acre located at 900 ft elevation on top of the appellation facing south-east.

Certified biodynamic since 2017

## **HARVEST**

Manual harvested & carefully sorted grapes in the vineyard and at entrance of cellar.

# VINIFICATION

Indigenous yeast fermentation in 350L oak barrels (40% new) for 18 months with lees stirring as needed.

# **TASTING NOTES**

Light gold with green highlights. Mineral shades combine with lemon, baked apple, fig, fern, cinnamon and honeysuckles. Elegant and pure, smooth and round, aromas of young exotics fruits, honey and gingerbread.
