

Domaine Comte Senard ALOXE-CORTON LES CAILLETTES BLANC AOC Aloxe-Corton

Domaine Comte Senard had an auspicious start in 1857 when Jules Senard, the great grandfather of current owner Philippe Senard, created the Corton- Clos des Meix monopole. Since that time, the Domaine has continued its acquisition of property in prestigious appellations, with current holdings of 22 acres of land. Passed down for 5 generations, since 2005 it has been under the management of Lorraine Senard. The Domaine produces wines that are seductive representations of the power of Corton, built to age with finesse and grace.



COUNTRY

France

VARIETAL

Pinot Gris (Pinot Beurot) from 70 years old vines

SOIL TYPE

Reddish brown with flint and limestone debris and rich in potassium and phosphoric acid.

VINEYARD

0.23 acre and a very rare vineyard of white in Aloxe-Corton located at 900 ft elevation.

Certified biodynamic since 2017

HARVEST

Manual harvested & carefully sorted grapes in the vineyard and at entrance of cellar.

VINIFICATION

Indigenous yeast fermentation in one 350L oak barrels for 18 months with lees stirring as needed.

TASTING NOTES

Golden color with amber highlights. Aromas of undergrowth, burnt vine shoots, moss, mushrooms, dried fruit, apricot, honey, beeswax, gingerbread. On the palate, a lot of substance, a nice roundness, nice freshness.
