AOC Puligny Montrachet 1er Cru Les Perrières

An amazing story not typical of Burgundy! The Bzikot family are Polish emigrants whom arrived in Puligny just before World War II with nothing but their clothes on. From those very humble beginnings working in various domaines of Burgundy, this family has managed to acquire an impressive domaine of 4ha of some of the best vineyards in the village of Puligny-Montrachet. With minimal intervention in the vineyards and cellar, Sylvain Bzikot produces wines that are at one ripe and rich, yet elegant and complex. Affable and fun-loving, he is one of the underground wine making stars of the region.



COUNTRY

France

VARIETAL

Chardonnay

SOIL TYPE

Limestone-Clay

VINEYARD

0.15 Ha only for this Premier Cru vineyard Les Perrières, located south east of the Village of Puligny.

HARVEST

Hand harvested and hand sorted grapes in the vineyard and at the entrance of the winery.

VINIFICATION

Very slow and gentle pneumatic press to respect the fruit. The wine goes then directly into barrels after being decanted to reduce the sediment.

Elevage is around 15 months in oak barrels with 25% new oak before six months in stainless steel vats to keep its freshness.

TASTING NOTES

Brilliant gold color with a pale green rim. Aromas of white flowers, lime-tree, linden, lemon curd and almond paste followed by dried fruits, honey, hints of spices and loads of minerals. Very seductive with a wonderful silky texture. Tuna, Lobster, crab, white meat, mushrooms. Foie Gras and noble fish like turbot or monkfish.

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
