



Mas Amiel

NATURAL CINSAUT

IGP Côte Catalane

In the South of France, 20 miles from Perpignan, Mas Amiel is protected by the Corbières to the North and the Pyrenees to the South. When Olivier Decelle, Owner since 1999 and Marcel, Winemaker discovered this exceptional location, they decided to establish Mas Amiel as an internationally renowned wine estate.

The strength of this domaine resides in the richness and diversity of its terroir, climates and grape varieties. A superb terroir of calcoschistes that come from the imbrication and compression of pure clay (forming the schist) and limestone (erosion of the limestone massifs depositing over the clays).

VARIETAL

Cinsault

SOIL TYPE

Limestone-schist terroir in the district of Las Fredes

VINEYARD

Organic and biodynamic(100%). Several plots of Cinsault planted in a limestone-schist terroir in the district of Las Fredes.

HARVEST

Hand-picked and double sorted grapes bunches on a conveyor belt and a vibrating table before destemming.

VINIFICATION

In 50-hl stainless steel vats. Natural yeast without inputs of SO2. Gentle winemaking with an infusion, entirely respecting the textures of the fruit and the soil.

TASTING NOTES

Bright red with garnet tints. The initial aromas are very floral, followed by fresh red berry notes. Smooth on the palate. It reveals a refined texture with a very juicy side.
