



In the South of France, 20 miles from Perpignan, Mas Amiel is protected by the Corbières to the North and the Pyrenees to the South. When Olivier Decelle, Owner since 1999 and Marcel, Winemaker discovered this exceptional location, they decided to establish Mas Amiel as an internationally renowned wine estate.

The strength of this domaine resides in the richness and diversity of its terroir, climates and grape varieties. A superb terroir of calcoschistes that come from the imbrication and compression of pure clay (forming the schist) and limestone (erosion of the limestone massifs depositing over the clays).

SOIL TYPE

Granitic arena, gneiss and micaschist on the Maury terroir

Carefully selected parcels and complementary grape varieties Oriented south

HARVEST

Manual harvest Biodynamic cultivation

VINIFICATION

Double manual sorting of bunches on conveyor belt and vibrating table, destemming before vinification in 50 hl stainless steel vats. Grenache and Carignan are vinified together.

TASTING NOTES

Fresh and juicy aromas of grapes, followed by a basket of fresh strawberries, raspberries and blackberries. Notes of dried rose petals combine with wild cherries and rockrose. It then offers a trip into a more sappy, aniseed and mentholated universe.
