



Isabel Ferrando has taken her estate to France's highest level since her first release in 2003. She purchased Domaine Saint-Préfert from the Serre family, one of the first to estate-bottle in the appellation in the 1930's. With help from daughter Guillemette, they produce some of the most profound wines on earth today. Isabel's mentality is to always improve: "The substantial work done in the vineyards over the past 20 years brings us ever closer to the level of quality that I seek." After working for 18 years with the vineyard surrounding the Saint Préfert winery, Ferrando decided to follow the tradition of blending and now makes a single wine from that site. Domaine Saint Préfert and Isabel Ferrando joined under the name Famille Isabel Ferrando with the 2020 vintage release. The estate earned its certification for 100% biodynamic farming techniques in 2019.
