DOCG Barbaresco Bricco Faset

The winery is composed of 24 hectares of estate vineyards and 4 cascine (farmsteads: La Spinona, La Ghiga, Albina, and Bergera). The heart of Barbaresco, a town in the UNESCO region of Piedmont, is home to 20 hectares of these vineyards. aAt La Spinona, Barbaresco wine has been a family affair for five generations. Since the last century, the Berutti family has placed its faith in the hills surrounding the town of Barbaresco, a place that is particularly suited to producing exceptional wines.

Nebbiolo

SOIL TYPE

Limestone and stoney with sand

VINEYARD

3 hectares in the Faset MGA. 40 y/o vines 270 meters above sea level South, south-east exposition

HARVEST

Manual harvest Early November for late years Dried grapes and leaves eliminated

VINIFICATION

Grapes cleaned on a vibrating roller
Racking and gentle pressing
9 months aging
Large 38-40hl wooden barrels
Allier and Slavonian Oak.
12 months aging in bottle

TASTING NOTES

Ruby red colour, and tends to garnet red with ageing. Bouquet of wild berries, spices (white pepper, licorice), and some aromatic herbs (pine, white mint and laurel). It is velvety, balanced and elegant on the palate.
