The winery is composed of 24 hectares of estate vineyards and 4 cascine (farmsteads: La Spinona, La Ghiga, Albina, and Bergera). The heart of Barbaresco, a town in the UNESCO region of Piedmont, is home to 20 hectares of these vineyards. At La Spinona, Barbaresco wine has been a family affair for five generations. Since the last century, the Berutti family has placed its faith in the hills surrounding the town of Barbaresco, a place that is particularly suited to producing exceptional wines.

4 ha. 40 y/o vines 270 meters above sea level South, south-east exposition

HARVEST

Manual harvest

VINIFICATION

Grapes cleaned on a vibrating roller
Racking and gentle pressing
12 months aging stainless steel vats

8-10 months aging in bottle

TASTING NOTES

Langhe Nebbiolo has a ruby red colour that tends to garnet red with ageing. The aroma is clean and intense with floral and fruity hints, notably rose, raspberry along with peach notes. The taste is fresh, dry, enhanced by the right amount of sapidity.
