



El Jefe [grande] is a one liter bottle of Tempranillo produced from a single estate in Castilla y Leon (Zamorra) just south of Toro. The family has been growing grapes in this region for three generations. They time their harvest and ferment in breathable cement tanks to express the natural strength, sinewy agility, balance and fresh nature of Tempranillo of the area. Sourced from a single 180 acre family estate in the northern table lands "La Meseta," the elevated, high plains desert of Castilla y Leon. North of the ancient city of Salamanca and just south of the region of Toro.
