

Casa Mariol VERMUT BLANC DO Terra Alta

Cellar Mariol is a third genaration family winery, founded in 1945. it is situated is Betea, Terra Alta, a small region tucked away in the south of Catalonia, where the wine sector is of great significance and bears tradition. The dry Mediterrnean climate, mostly calcareous soils and combination of two prevailing winds, the dry north (el cierzo) and moist southeast (el garbi), provide optimal conditions for growing grapes. These factors, along with the esteem for the 50 hectares of vineyards as well as other small farms in the region, allow them to make their wines and vermouths, products that reflect the uniqueness of their territory and people. The clear and strong commitment to sustainable agriculture is how they contribute to the care and protection of the landscape and how they foster their people's roots.

At Cellar Mariol they are dedicated to producing fine single-variety vermouths and wines, in bottles with a very distinct design by German art director, Mirko Borsche.

Lemon-yellow colour. Sweet and pleasant entry nose, intense, refreshing and prolonged. Aromas of rosemary and thyme, citrus cotes and touches of vanilla. Ideal as an aperitif with olives, salted almonds or potato chips. Perfect for a glamorous evening; and at any time, well chilled, on it's own or combined with a toonic to tranform it into an even more surprising drink.
