

Domaine Georges Glantenay AOC Pommard

Coming from a line of winegrowers from father to son since the 17th century, this domaine located in Volnay in Côte-d'Or, Burgundy, is a family winery born from the sharing of the estate of Pierre Glantenay in 1893. After his son Georges then his grandson Pierre, it is now the fourth generation who is at the head of the estate, represented by Guillaume and Sarah, brother and sister. This domaine has 8 hectares of vines, managed in organic practices agriculture, with the greatest respect for the terroir. They strive every day to maintain and embellish the family heritage, but also to expand it as soon as an opportunity arises.

VARIETAL Pinot noir

SOIL TYPE Clay-limestone and silt

VINEYARD

26.80 ares 55-75 year old vines Les Riottes, Le Poisot, Les Combes Dessous

HARVEST

Manual harvesting & rigorous selective sorting.

VINIFICATION

Cold pre-fermentation maceration for 7 days, temperature-controlled. Vatting 21 days. Aging on fine lees in oak barrels. 20% new barrels. Old-fashioned racking with brokereau. Bottled by gravity on the estate.

TASTING NOTES

Intense dark garnet color, well-balanced nose with notes of black cherry and blackcurrant, followed by leather and undergrowth with age. The ample palate reveals firm tannins, softened by a beautiful roundness. Its aromatic potential promises a wine for laying down.

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
