Domaine De Rabusas was started in 2001 when David Givaudan purchased 20 hectares of vineyards around the village of Cavillargues specializing in Cotes du Rhone and "Vin de Pays" appellations. He has chosen to acquire vigorous vineyards with very specific terroirs (clay & limestone), and generous sun exposure producing grapes rich in aromas and texture. **COUNTRY**

France

**VARIETAL**

70% Grenache & 30% Syrah

**SOIL TYPE**

Stony soils with limestone gravel from the Rhône River's ancient terraces.

**VINEYARD**

Laudun is one of the 20 villages that are permitted to add their names to the Cotes du Rhone Villages appellation, having been identified as producing higher-quality wines distinctive of the regional style.

**HARVEST**

Mechanically harvested & sorted

**VINIFICATION**

Traditional fermentation in concrete tank and used 600L Rhone Valley oak barrels.

**TASTING NOTES**

Ruby red with notes of cassis, plums and fresh red berries with hints of liquorice, spices and truffle. supple but generous mouth feel with velvety tannins.

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
