

# **Domaine Georges Glantenay**

AOC Pommard 1er Cru Les Combes Dessus

Coming from a line of winegrowers from father to son since the 17th century, this domaine located in Volnay in Côte-d'Or, Burgundy, is a family winery born from the sharing of the estate of Pierre Glantenay in 1893. After his son Georges then his grandson Pierre, it is now the fourth generation who is at the head of the estate, represented by Guillaume and Sarah, brother and sister.

This domaine has 8 hectares of vines, managed in organic practices agriculture, with the greatest respect for the terroir. They strive every day to maintain and embellish the family heritage, but also to expand it as soon as an opportunity arises.

Only 4 barrels produced. Powerful and complex aromas of small red and black fruits (raspberry, currant, black cherry). An ample, tender, well-balanced mouthfeel with melted and elegant tannins, which finishes on a broad aromatic complexity.
